## Abstract

Psoriasis is a chronic inflammatory immune-mediated skin diseases, frequently associated to systemic comorbidities. According to recent data, patients with psoriasis show a greater prevalence of metabolic syndrome, which confers an higher cardiovascular risk factors. The link between these pathological conditions appears to be a chronic low-grade inflammatory status. The aim of this review is to focus on the multiple epidemiological and physio-pathogenetic aspects linking NAFLD psoriasis, and cardiovascular disease.
