Abstract

Suicide, as a cause of death, affects every global health system, and is a particular problem in low and middle income countries (which account for 75% of suicide deaths) and in heavily urbanised states. More than 800,000 commit suicide each year. The World Health Organisation (WHO) records that 1.4% of annual global deaths are caused by suicide, and that suicide was the second leading cause of death in 15-29 year olds across the world in 2012. Jumping from height accounts for 3 - 15% of the 140,000 suicide attempts in the UK each year, a similar incidence to the rest of Europe. Emergency departments that receive patients who jump from a height need to have an understanding of the potential pathology that is likely to be encountered in
