### Abstract

The primary systemic vasculitides (PSV) are a group of rare inflammatory disorders affecting blood vessels of varying size and multiple organs. Urological manifestations of PSV are uncommon. Testicular vasculitis is the most commonly reported finding and is associated with Polyarteritis Nodosa (PAN), Henoch-Schönlein Purpura (HSP), anti-neutrophil cytoplasm antibody associated Vasculitides (AAV), Giant Cell Arteritis (GCA) and Kawasaki's Disease.
