The Yale Food **Addiction** Scale and the Binge Eating Scale were used to characterize food **addiction** and binge eating, respectively. Results: The mean baseline age and BMI were  $32.1 \pm 11.1$  years and  $44.9 \pm 4.9$  kg/m<sup>2</sup>, respectively. Pre-surgery, food **addiction**, and binge eating were identified in 40.7% and 48.1% of patients, respectively.
