

In support for the metacognitive model, a meta-analysis reported a strong association between metacognitions and anxiety symptoms in children and adolescents aged 7-17 years across eight studies including 2613 participants, r = .48, 95% CI [.41, .55] (Lønfeldt et al., Reference Lønfeldt, Silverman and Esbjørn 2017).


