Diagnostic dilemma of coagulation problems in an hiv-positive patient with end-stage liver disease undergoing liver transplantation

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Abstract

Human immunodeficiency virus (HIV) may result in devastating multi-organ complications, including cirrhosis. Consequently, liver transplantation is often required. We report a case of a 43-year-old female with cryptogenic cirrhosis and HIV on highly active antiretroviral therapy, presenting for a non-related living donor liver transplant. The intra-operative course was complicated by hepatic artery and portal vein
