

The hallmark of the syndrome, as was originally described by Lemierre, is a tetrad of acute oropharyngeal infection, septicemia, thrombophlebitis of the ipsilateral internal jugular vein (IJV), and secondary metastatic abscesses, most commonly to the lungs and joints.
