"Distinctive aspects of peptic ulcer disease, Dieulafoy's lesion, and Mallory-Weiss syndrome in patients with advanced alcoholic liver disease or cirrhosis" by Nojkov B, and Cappell MS.

This paper is submitted as a review article to World Journal of Gastroenterology #21765.

This review reports previously published statistics on previously published data, but does not report any new statistical analyses.
