I have reviewed the statistical section & results of the manuscript "Clinical Impact of self-expanding metal stents (SEMS) in patients with malignant colorectal obstruction: A systematic review and meta-analysis". The primary outcome of interest in this manuscript is to evaluate endoscopically placed SEMS technique. Parameters studied in this technique were technical & clinical success rate, rate of occurrence of adverse events and rate of need for re-interventions.

We used the DerSimonian-Laird random effects model to pool the data across the studies and to obtain overall estimates (in percentages) and the 95% confidence intervals (CIs). Statistical heterogeneity among studies was evaluated by using the Cochran Q statistic and quantified by I^2 statistics.
