General information

Calcyclin Binding Protein, also called Siah-1 Interacting Protein (CacyBP/SIP), is a component of the ubiquitination pathway. Study showed that defects in G1 arrest led to an increase in embryonic fibroblast growth rate in SIP^{-/-} mice, CacyBP/SIP could promote G1/S transition of pancreatic cancer cells and regulate the glucose limitation-induced p27 degradation. In gastric cancer tissue, it was found that CacyBP/SIP expressed in the nuclei and could translocate into nucleus induced by gastrin and promote the cell proliferation. But the mechanism is unclear. In this present investigation, the mechanism of CacyBP/SIP nuclear translocation promoting the growth in gastric cancer cells is studied.

Procedures and possible risks

For patients with stomach cancer undergoing stomach operation, stomach cancer specimens will be taken after the operation. The taking of stomach biopsies is very safe, and will not affect the diagnosis of pathologist on the resected specimen pathology.
