Projekt navn: Forebyggelse af hudkomplikationer til insulinpumpe og sensor hos børn og unge med type 1 diabetes

Lægmandsresumé: Flere og flere børn og unge lever med type 1 diabetes. I moderne behandling indgår både insulinpumpe og/eller sensor med mange fordele, men desværre viser vores store studie, at over halvdelen af børn og unge udvikler hudkomplikationer til denne behandling. Dette kliniske studie vil derfor undersøge hudbarrieren, følge nye patienter med pumpe/sensor på 3 hospitaler og undersøge tilgængelige data fra registre omkring behandling og forebyggelse af hudkomplikationer.

Formål: Formålet med forskningsprojektet er først og fremmest at forebygge udviklingen af hudkomplikationer ved brug af insulinpumpe og/eller sensor hos børn og unge med type 1 diabetes. Derudover er formålet også at finde mulige risikofaktorer for udvikling af hudkomplikationer samt undersøge nærmere omkring hudbarrieren, således at en bedre behandling af hudkomplikationer kan tilrettelægges.

Grant notification letter for a co-financed PhD scholarship from the Danish Diabetes Academy

Dear Anna Korsgaard Berg

Thank you for your application for a PhD scholarship to the Danish Diabetes Academy (DDA).

We are pleased to inform you that the DDA has decided to offer you a 2/3 co-financed PhD scholarship grant of

DKK 1,100,000 in total

to your project "*Prevention and Treatment of Dermatological Complications Associated with Continuous Subcutaneous Insulin Infusion and/or Continuous Glucose Monitoring in Pediatric Patients with Type 1 Diabetes*".

Conditions

The allocation of the PhD scholarship grant is subject to the condition that you have a Master's degree or an equivalent degree from a foreign university. As you had not obtained your Master's degree when you applied for the grant, we kindly ask you to forward your Master's degree certificate to us within six months after receiving this grant notification letter, i.e. 4 June 2019 (see below).

The grant covers 2/3 of the expenses for your salary, including tuition fee, up to the maximum amount of DKK 1,100,000 in total, for the specific project applied for. The grant is therefore personal and cannot be passed on to another project or person.

The PhD scholarship grant is subject to the condition that full financing has been obtained for the entire PhD term (i.e. three years). Therefore, we kindly ask you to forward documentation of the remaining 1/3 financing in terms of a grant letter or the like (e.g. signed guarantee from principal supervisor and head of department) no later than six months after receiving this grant notification letter, i.e. 4 June 2019. Otherwise, the PhD scholarship grant will be withdrawn.

Furthermore, we kindly ask you to note the following:

- The DDA does not cover running costs in relation to the proposed project. If you need further financial support for your project, we encourage you to apply for funding elsewhere.
- The DDA cannot fund your project further than the DKK 1,100,000.
- Any unused funds from the grant must be returned to the DDA. Upon written request and approval by the DDA Board of Directors, any unused funds may be used for your salary only and only for a short period of time in direct continuation of the employment period that is covered by the DDA grant.
- In case of resignation from the position as PhD student, the remaining funds from the DDA grants must also be returned to the DDA.

Finally, the allocation of the PhD scholarship grant is subject to the condition that you submit an annual scientific report through the Novo Nordisk Foundation's researchfish® web-based reporting system by 1 December each year during the grant period and up to five years after (starting 2019). For further information, see the section "Commitment to the DDA" below.

Enrolment and employment

The allocation of the PhD scholarship grant is subject to the condition that you will be enrolled and admitted as a PhD student at the Faculty of Health and Medical Science, University of Copenhagen. Therefore, we kindly ask you to contact the main supervisor of the project, Associate Professor Jannet Svensson, in order to prepare an actual application for admission at the above-mentioned faculty. Please note that you also need to confirm that you are not already enrolled as a PhD student at the time of receiving this grant notification letter (see below).

As soon as you have been accepted at the university, please forward a copy of your enrolment letter from the university to the DDA Executive Management Team (see below).

The university where you are enrolled will be responsible for the employment of you as a PhD student. The DDA will have no influence on the employment other than allocating the grant to your host institution Herlev and Gentofte Hospital.

Employment must take place at the latest six months after receiving this grant notification letter, i.e. 4 June 2019 or by agreement with the DDA.

In case of legitimate leave of absence, such as maternal or paternal leave, the project period can be prolonged, but other kind of leave of absence has to be accepted by the DDA and your host institution, and a request has to be forwarded to the DDA Executive Management Team. The host institution is expected to cover any additional expenditure in connection with leave of absence.

Payment

The payment of DKK 1,100,000 will be made by the DDA to your host institution Herlev and Gentofte Hospital in two payments upon receipt of an electronic invoice sent to the DDA as outlined below:

We kindly ask you to inform the PhD administration at the faculty where you are enrolled to forward the first electronic invoice to the DDA no later than 30 June 2019. The second invoice must be forwarded to the DDA no later than 30 June 2020.

If the DDA has not received an electronic invoice for the first payment by 30 June 2019, the PhD scholarship grant can be withdrawn.

Commitment to the DDA

The DDA requires that you as a PhD student meet the following requirements during your PhD scholarship:

- You will have to be a member of the DDA faculty (sign up at our website: www.danishdiabetesacademy.dk).
- You may be asked to teach or give lectures within the DDA framework.
- You must submit an annual scientific report through the Novo Nordisk Foundation's researchfish® web-based reporting system each year by 1 December (starting 2019) during the grant period and up to five years after the end of the PhD scholarships term. Login details and further information will be send to you in due time.
- You must send a final report (1-1 ½ page) to the DDA Executive Management Team at the end of your PhD scholarship term (at the latest three months after). The report must include:
 - A status of the project and progress in relation to the project description including any deviations from the project description
 - A financial report from the Accounts Department of your host institution with documentation of the salary paid out to you (e.g. salary extract)
- At the end of your PhD scholarship term, the DDA will ask you to complete a questionnaire regarding the benefit you have derived from the DDA PhD scholarship including learning outcome of the DDA PhD courses and the strengthening of your competences.

Acknowledgements

The DDA Executive Management Team must be informed about any publications arising from the project or any public mention related to the project by e-mail to ouh.dda@rsyd.dk.

Furthermore, please note the following with regard to acknowledgements:

- The DDA must be mentioned in all publications arising from the project- either under 'Funding' or 'Acknowledgements'. Please state: *"This work was supported by a research grant from the Danish Diabetes Academy, which is funded by the Novo Nordisk Foundation, grant number NNF17SA0031406"*.
- Oral and poster presentations on scientific conferences must also include the DDA logo. You can download our logo from our website to use in your presentations: <https://www.danishdiabetesacademy.dk/about/downloads/official-logo>
- If your project receives public mention (social media, newspapers, radio etc.), it must be stated that *"the PhD scholarship is supported by the Danish Diabetes Academy, which is funded by the Novo Nordisk Foundation"*.
