This paper is well written, but this reviewer wants to know several additional points. 1 After RARP, why the doctors did not select cystoscopy or radiographic evaluation such as CT or MRI because prostatic MC had normal PSA value. 2 Please tell me the details of recurrent BT; tumor size, tumor shape (cauliflower shape is not suitable for scientific paper), all the site in the bladder at each recurrence time, pathological T stage.
