a) The state of the art should be extended because it does not exist. b) It should be structured and organized in the standard sections: introduction, materials and methods, results, discussion and conclusions. c) In the discussion section, the presented work should be compared with other similar ones to establish the advances and limitations of the presented work. d) The conclusions should summarize the scientific contribution of the work and establish a set of lines of future work.
