I congratulate the authors for their well written and thorough literature review of bronchogenic cysts. I personally believe that in extremely rare pathologies, and especially in the retroperitoneum, case reports are very important, in an attempt to better define their more typical characteristics and support decision making. I would like to know how the cyst was drained and whether there was spillage of its content. Usually we do not drain small cysts, especially because we do not know the exact pathology, and we fear of dissemination and recurrence when spillage occurs.
