I personally believe that in extremely rare pathologies, and especially in the retroperitoneum, case reports are very important, in an attempt to better define their more typical characteristics and support decision making. Usually we do not drain small cysts, especially because we do not know the exact pathology, and we fear of dissemination and recurrence when spillage occurs.
