After having carefully read your manuscript, I will point out several problems in your report. First, your title of report will be not appropriate. I suggest the following example; "A difficult case of the plastic surgery for giant metastatic endometrioid adenocarcinoma in abdominal wall: a case report" Second, you emphasized that your highlight is the design of the reconstruction of the abdominal wall after resection in Introduction. However, you don't describe the reconstruction of abdominal wall. Therefore, you should focus the importance and novelty of plastic surgical procedure in your case. Finally, the description of your cited references did not suitable for our journal. Please correct it according to guideline for authors.

In the paper entitled: "Surgery of big abdominal wall infected metastatic lesion of endometrioid adenocarcinoma: a case report" by Wang et al. the Authors report the surgical reconstruction of the abdominal wall in a case of metastatic endometrioid carcinoma. The case may be of particular interest as regards the surgical aspects of patient management. Therefore I advise the authors to expand these aspects in the discussion section. The authors speak of infection. What pathogens was it caused by? What kind of antibiotic therapy was given? The histological picture is not very clear. Please provide a higher resolution image, showing the original magnification, staining and scale bar. It might be an idea to add a photomicrograph of the p53 immunostain.
