## SPECIFIC COMMENTS TO AUTHORS

The authors discuss a case of PVT after partial liver resection. The discussion prevention and treatment. Suggestions: 1- introduction and background in the abstract and article need to be redone. It needs to discuss incidence of PVT after liver surgery and in patients with primary liver cancer in non cirrhosis patients. 2- article needs to discuss guidelines and different society recommendations on non cirrhosis PVT. 3- the last paragraph in discussion about expert opinion needs to be supported by case reports or evidence to support this expert opinion. Like when to use LMWH or warfarin. Why not LMWH? 4- the authors recommend prevention of PVT after liver surgery? I think it would be better to discuss the pro and cons of each approach. The need to justify preventive measures for rare cases.
