The authors describe a case of urticaria associated with adenocarcinoma, but there is still room for clarification. 1. The article describes the high expression of TTF-1 (thyroid nuclear factor 1) in lung tissue and its relationship with lung cancer. It seems that it has little relationship with urticaria? 2. There is no direct evidence in the article to support that urticaria is related to lung cancer, urticaria or skin changes caused by lymphoma are more, and there is no skin pathological support? 3. There is no image of enhanced chest CT in the patient data? 4. Are there any abnormalities in the patient's blood tumor indicators, and are there any correlations with urticaria?
