"In the current study, we evaluated the serum CA125 levels in a cohort of 108 sarcoidosis patients and compared the results those from a cohort of 112 healthy controls. This represents, to our knowledge, the first retrospective study evaluating the association of the levels of CA125 with clinical characteristics and suggesting that CA125 could be a potential diagnostic biomarker in sarcoidosis." paragraph should be moved to materials and methods.
