The discussion section would be redundant. Please concise it. 4. Abbreviations should be opened at the first use, and applied consistently (e.g., CTU). 5. In discussion section, 'Bladder malacoplakia is an extremely rare disease. There are only 17 reports of 31 cases of bladder malacoplakia in China from 1986 to 2021.' --> Please changed into results on worldwide beside China.
