The following revisions are recommended; 1. Clinicopathologic, immunohistochemical, and molecular findings of previously reported cases should be summarized in a Table. 2. The authors should revise some spelling errors. 3. The manuscript should include a color figure of FISH, demonstrating EWS-FLI1 gene translocation. 4. In the discussion section, other small cell tumors in the pathological differential diagnosis of this rare tumor should be described in detail.
