SPECIFIC COMMENTS TO AUTHORS

The manuscript reported a 3-year-old girl with growth retardation, language retardation, brain atrophy, convulsions, and growth hormone deficiency, and the diagnosis of Aicardi-Goutières syndrome type 7 was established. The subject of the study is interesting, but there are some concerns about the manuscript: - There are still some spelling and grammatical errors, such as Background, or “.... achieved his goals by crying and shouting ...” - There are some unnecessary abbreviations in the text, such as: “Since age 6 mo”, or “..... each lasting about 2 min” - In the Abstract, it was mentioned that the child was 5 years old, while in the text the age of the child at the presentation was 3 years old - The ethical issues and permission for reporting the patient’s information are missing - The discussion is too short and the review of the similar studies is missing
