Good morning, this is a very interesting article, which appears as a therapeutic option in patients with high anesthetic risk. However, I consider that it cannot be applied to all patients with gallbladder pathology. My suggestions are the following: 1. Describe which gallbladder pathologies can be resolved by this technique and which patients meet the criteria. Should it be taken for cholecystitis, pancreatitis and anatomical variations? 2. In case of intraoperative complications with this technique, what do you recommend doing? 3. Is the surgical technique the same? Are there error traps that can be avoided?
