Dear Authors, This is an interesting case report Hereditary spastic paraplegia. The case report is generally well described with a strong message regarding the newly discovered pathogenic mutation that mentioned in manuscript, expanding the existing knowledge of the spectrum of mutations of SPG4. . However, certain points have to be addressed in order to enhance the scientific quality of this case report: 1) In line 103, fever in his right knee should be changed to hotness of his right knee. 2) In line 112, There was no muscle amyotrophy should be corrected to There was no muscle atrophy 3) In line 112, fibrillation should be corrected to fasciculation, clawfoot to claw-feet 4) The following sentence (There was no muscle amyotrophy, muscle tract fibrillation, and abnormal involuntary movement. He was intellectually normal and had no ataxia, cognitive impairment, peripheral neuropathy, bladder dysfunction, clawfoot, and scoliosis) have English a grammar problem regarding the use of negative sentence? 5) In line 135 the following sentence (weakness and spasticity of both lower limbs in his 40 years and had required a cane to walk in his 60 years) should be corrected to (weakness and spasticity of both lower limbs at age 40 years and at age 60 years he start using cane to walk) 5) In



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line 255 what you mean by (avoiding neuro-disease-inducing substances)? it should be changed to appropriate pharmacological term. 6)The examination of his nervous system showed increased muscle tension? here what you mean by muscle tension, did you mean tone?? 7) in line 110, you should explain what type of muscle weakness does the patient had? is it proximal, distal or pyramidal? please you have to re-write the physical examination using appropriate neurological terms with detailed neurological examination. 8) Can you please upload the lab. result for the studied gene with manuscript files.

The authors need to address the following concerns or questions. The SPRS scale evaluation should be included in the text and summarized in the Table. Moreover, bioinformatic methods should be reported in details (Mutation Taster, Polyphen-2, SIFT, Provean). See Carosi et al, JNNP 2015 (see Suppl. File). The English language needs an improvement.
