It is often misdiagnosed as benign stromal proliferative lesions or benign mesenchymal tumors of the breast because of its mild morphology. In this study, the authors reported the clinical data of two cases of fibromatosis-like metaplastic carcinoma of the breast and performed pathomorphological observation and immunohistochemical staining of the surgically resected specimens. The cases are very interesting, and the manuscript is well written. The reviewer recommends to accept this manuscript after a minor editing.
