Specify what makes this article different from the rest of studies that are available in the literature. 2. Identify the gap in exiting literature, by arguing what is missing or inadequate in existing solutions and thus your study is necessary. This needs to be briefly noted in Introduction, and then further elaborated in the Literature Review, with in-depth analysis and substantiation of citations. 3.It would be helpful in clarifying the importance of the proposed study if the paper can include references to some latest articles published in recent years within the scope of the current research. 4. Discussion of results/findings, needs to related to previous literature and compare and contrast the findings/claims against that of previous studies.
