The authors have presented a rare case of splenic littoral cell angioma. However, I consider the report is not well-prepared. 1. The description was not clear, and the formats was not met a standard case report. 2. The conclusion of abstract should be modified and precise. 3. Case presentation should be combined in a whole section. 4. "Further diagnostic work-up" did not mean operation and pathological findings. 5. It is unclear for the association between splenectomy and subsequent liver failure. 6. The discussion seemed like to be another study, rare connection between the case and the discussion.

The only thing that leaves some doubt is the fact that it was not possible to know the exact cause of the patient's death. The figures are easy to understand and the table is very explanatory. I believe it can be accepted as it is without notable changes
