SPECIFIC COMMENTS TO AUTHORS

The relevant case reports of functioning gonadotroph adenoma are not uncommon, leading to the lack of the vitality and the creativity. However, it is still worth reading due to the relatively complete clinical data and follow-up. There are still several aspects in the manuscript that are open to question. 1. In the CASE SUMMARY section (line 39)," and prolactin (PRL) levels were elevated " is misstated. 2. With the "transsphenoidal surgery" of this disease having been recommended before, although the author has used this surgical scheme and had a good outcome, it is suggested to elaborate on new developments such as Gamma knife radiosurgery (GKRS), which may help readers to keep abreast of the latest developments. 3. The functioning gonadotroph adenoma can occur in postmenopausal women, men, or children, and it is recommended that it be mentioned in the discussion.
