The authors have presented an interesting case. There are some concerns. 1. The authors mentioned 3 times about "The prognosis of SMEGC is poor." It is not clear, compared with what? Mean 5-years survival? Please clarify it. 2. "Initially, the patient was going to be treated exclusively with endoscopic submucosal dissection; however, a laparoscopic resection was chosen for the major lesion, while ESD was performed on the minor lesion." Why? 3. "however, little is known about the pathogenesis of the development of multiple gastric cancers." Could this situation be associated with genetic factors? Please provide more information. 4. "H. pylori (7 times)" were not presented the same and correct. They must be italicized in the whole article. 5. "SMEGC" must be used in the discussion, using the whole name again (3 times) in the discussion was not necessary. 6. "greater than 10 years" could be modified to "more than 10 years". The use of irbesartan should include the dose and frequency.
