Authors described 3 patients with relapsing polychondritis with ANCA-associated vasculitis. Straight forward cases, but first patient deserves further explanation and discussion about cause of death. Hemophagocytic syndrome needs to be included in the differential diagnoses and one wonders if this diagnosis was on their mind when bone marrow biopsy was performed and interpreted.
