COMMENTS TO AUTHORS

This is an exceptionally poorly written manuscript that oversteps the limited clinical observation and draws conclusions that aren't supported. Most of the paragraphs are single sentences with significant grammatical errors. However, the most troubling is the final sentence "Our case reports demonstrate that cabazitaxel improves PFS and overall survival in patients with brain metastases...." Do you believe 3 cases (not in a randomized trial) demonstrates PFS or OS improvement?

The issue is original and clinically relevant. However, I suggest some minor revisions in order to improve the quality of the manuscript: 1. Language improvement should be performed. 2. Data presented in the manuscript should not repeat data in the table. 3. Data reported in the manuscript should allow patient identification (patient 1, 2 or 3). 4. The type of androgen deprivation therapy received by patients should be reported.
