COMMENTS TO AUTHORS

Comments to the author: This case report attempts to shed light on a rare complication of Meckel's diverticulum, i. e. incarceration into a paraduodenal hernia. The author should better explain the existing terminological variety in this field. This could enable him to perform a more precise and reliable information retrieval in several data-bases and information portals. It seems likely that similar cases have already been reported elsewhere, too. There is a citation to a very recent paper in the World Journal of Gastroenterology as well. That is why author's intent to convince the readership that the manuscript deals with a first case in the world literature should be better substantiated. The text needs certain language improvements. For example, the word 'drainaged' should read 'drained', etc. The references should be prepared according to author's guidelines.
