COMMENTS TO AUTHORS

Major points: This is an interesting case report, which seems to provide readers with useful information. The manuscript is well written. Figure 2 (ABC); original magnification was not indicated. In A, it is difficult to evaluate the characteristics of each cells (higher magnification recommended), In B and C, there seems to exist discrepancies between S100 and CD1a. (also, higher magnified clear figures are recommended). In Figure 3, label A is missing, black (white) arrows, white arrow head and star are indicated, but they are not shown on the figure. In Figure 4, if schematic illustration showing normal (control) atlantoaxial joint with the same sagittal angle is presented as C, comparing with AB (label A is missing), it helps for readers to understand how the joint is disfigured in this case. Minor points: 1. autologus should be autologous 2. S. Gang report; should be Gang et al. report 3. L. Jiang repot; should be Jiang et al. report
