The authors have reported interesting case report of innominate and right common arterial aneurysm due to Takayasu’s arteritis, which was successfully treated by well-considered surgical strategy. I consider innominate artery aneurysm (IAA) due to



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Takayasu's arteritis is very rare and their clinical experience and consideration for therapeutic strategy is valuable. I have some minor comments. 1. "History of present illness" contains the issues of image findings and consideration for therapeutic strategy. Please divide these issues into "Imaging examinations" and "Treatment" section, respectively. 2. Please describe more details of "Physical examination" and "Laboratory examinations". 3. I consider IAA due to Takayasu's arteritis is very rare. Please indicate the incidence or number of reported cases in English literature and add short review of these series in discussion section. 4. In conclusion, please add following sentence "In conclusion, we reported a rare case of innominate and right common arterial aneurysm due to Takayasu's arteritis which was successfully treated by well-considered surgical strategy" before "Open surgery may be-".
