In this paper, Peng and colleagues reported a case of distal gastric cancer who underwent laparoscopic radical gastrectomy followed by natural orifice specimen extraction. Transrectal specimen extraction resulted in less trauma, better cosmetic appearance, and quick postoperative recovery. Although this is a single case report, this innovative technique provides a new approach to the treatment of gastric cancer with the laparoscopic NOSE method.
