This is an interesting case report of the management of a vascular perirenal tumor. Could the authors please respond to the following questions/comments? 1) The authors report that the CT describes “ a low density cystic shadow”. Were there any preop findings to suggest a mass of vascular origin? Did the authors consider doing an MRI? 2) During the operation it appears that the operating plan followed was to drain the cyst and then remove it. Is that correctly understood? How would that affect the possibility of a malignancy? 3) Still not completely clear as to the type of vascular tumor that this was. Could the authors present this maybe more clearly?
