The presented case report of a 7 year old girl provides important information in the aspect of COVID-19. However, I recommend authors should clarify how the clinical symptoms can be different from those in adults? Or at least revise the conclusion. Furthermore, it is not clear if live viruses were isolated from faecal and urine samples or just detected. I suggest to elaborate. The manuscript can further benefit from grammatical revisions. For example, indistinct (line 122) appears incorrect.
