The treatment of pilots with CRC is an interesting and important topic. This case report



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presents three typical cases for the diagnosis and treatment of pilots with CRC. CRC is treated individually according to patients' different conditions. Although there is no unified waiver rules for the pilots post-treatment of CRC, regular examination and appropriate treatment may help to improve the outcomes. The description of the cases is detailed and the the figures are illustrative. In the discussion section, the significance of early detection of CRC is highlighted and the importance of digital rectal examination is presented profoundly. The references are up-to-date enough. Only question is that capital letters should be used at the beginning of sentences and some minor grammatical errors shuold be corrected.
