Comments for Author's 1.In Introduction paragraph 2nd, line 2 and three omit the word 'can' 2.In paragraph 4th the bacteria name should be italic. 3.Beside the biochemical and imaging examination, do you examine any viral (HIV, Hepatitis B and C) or any bacterial pathogen in association with TTP, especially I am referring Arcanobacterium pyogenes 4.Did not mention the causative agent of TTP in case 5.The imaging examination like spleen infraction, renal infraction and widespread edema suggest the prolonged illness, while in the "CHIEF COMPLAINTS" section the author stated the typical angina with 3 days prior to presentation and no history of past illness, this scenario is a little confusing, is the patient had some hidden disease, if yes, whether you find that in your diagnosis or not?
