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## SPECIFIC COMMENTS TO AUTHORS

The authors present an interesting case of acute arterial thrombosis which occurred shortly in the post-operative period. The following are our recommendations. We recommend that the authors state if they had ruled out the presence of concomitant venous thrombosis in this patient. The authors should describe the current local or international guidelines for applying perioperative prophylaxis in patients undergoing prolonged ophthalmic surgery. The authors should describe if the patient had any pertinent lower extremity physical examination findings of the patient prior to the initiation of surgery. The authors should detail if a therapeutic aPTT level was achieved during the time the patient was on heparin therapy. Instances of Protein S deficiency and arterial thromboembolism have been reported (Cho et al. Protein C and/or S deficiency presenting as peripheral arterial insufficiency. Br J Radiol. 2005). The authors should state clearly if the presence of protein S deficiency in this patient could be a risk of developing arterial thrombosis in this patient.
