The vast majority of extranodal lymphomas are located in the palatine tonsil." 2. Please delete "and the ultrasound features have not been reported." from the sentence Core Tip: 3. Please delete "which was misdiagnosed as tonsillitis initially but was finally" from the sentence. INTRODUCTION 4. Please add percentage values to the statement: "Lymphomas of the head and neck arise from lymph nodes as well as extranodal sites, and the most frequent extranodal site is Waldever's ring, of which the palatine tonsil is the most commonly involved site [1]." 5. Please add "and/" before the "or" in the sentence: "Patients with tonsillar lymphomas may present with unilateral tonsil enlargement, sore throat, dysphagia OR lump in the throat OR neck[2]." 6. Please delete: "A correct" from the sentence "A correct diagnosis is challenging because of the unremarkable clinical presentation." 7. Please delete: "CT, MRI and PET/CT features of the tonsillar lymphomas have been described, while the ultrasound features have not been reported to the best of our knowledge[3-5]."
