What's the meaning of "Comparison of the Knowledge of New Coronary Virus in Fever Outpatients Before and After 5.3.1 Management Model" and "Comparison of 5.3.2 Knowledge of New Coronavirus between Two Groups"? Are those subheadings? If so, please make a revise, or delete them.
