SPECIFIC COMMENTS TO AUTHORS

Authors reported a case of ventricular tachycardia originating from the His bundle confirmed through evaluation of the electrocardiogram and intracardiac electrophysiologic examination. His bundle was ablated and a cardiac pacemaker was implanted to restore sinus rhythm. A few points regarding the manuscript: 1. How was the patient monitored in her follow-up visits? 2. Why were oral treatments such as Atorvastatin (10 mg qn), Furosemide (20 mg qd), Spironolactone (20 mg qd), and Irbesartan hydrochlorothiazide (1 tablet qd) prescribed to this patient? What effects do these drugs have in treating VT? 3. What is the ethnicity of this patient? Could this be a factor in the occurrence of the disease? 4. There is a spelling error on line 129. To "ablate" not to "ablating"
