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1. In "Physical examination upon admission" mentioned "His father died of lung cancer". I think it's a writing error. Please revise. 2. In DISCUSSION, "Our experience indicated the importance of early detection and comprehensive screening in patients with high risk of cancer". In fact, for all malignancies, early detection is crucial, not just multiple malignancies. Regrettably, the author did not discuss or offer the experience in the early detection or risk factors of multiple malignancies through this case. Suggest you rewrite the conclusion.
