Minor changes are required: 1. Page 8, line 174, the word tree should be three. 2. Page 9, lesions in the pancreas and colon were identified simultaneously in four of these cases and only one pancreatic cancer patient was presented with synchronous colon and liver metastases, please cite the references. 3. Minor English polishing is required avoiding any typos or grammatical errors.
