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#### **SPECIFIC COMMENTS TO AUTHORS**

The authors describe here a very interesting case of a patient with CLL/SLL that developed LCS on the skin, and there was no CLL/SLL in the skin lesion. The authors also put forth a possible mechanism for this occurrence, which is use of ibrutinib; this hypothesis is very intriguing, but needs further examination. Specific comments: Page 6, line 1: please use mm/cm for the diameter of the lymph node instead of the arbitrary "pigeon egg" Page 6, line 16: maybe replace "which they had" with "and they had" Page 8, line 6: "sKappa" instead of "sKsppa" Page 9, line 5: "As LCS is aggressive" instead of "As LCS aggressive" Page 9, line 11: "Leucocyte" instead of "leucocytes"
