1) Reword title to be less awkward... "COVID 19: While waiting for evidence based recommendations, there are off-label therapies based on drug mechanisms of action" or "COVID-19: Off-label therapies based on mechanism of action while waiting for evidence based recommendations" 2) Abstract introduction... Define SARS-Cov2 first time you use it. Second line: On May 15, 2029 (CORRECT DATE). remove "about" , pathophysiology not physiopathology. pandemic not pandemia (english translation), Repetition of deaths, drawling commentary by authors. Needs to be tighter in the introduction as it is loosely structured. 3) The body of the report is a bullet point list... This is like taking notes perhaps but seems inappropriate for a letter to the editor or peer-reviewed article Overall, this is a brief summary of the antiviral treatments out there but the formatting leaves a lot to be desired for in a peer-reviewed English speaking publication. There is also very little "meat" to the discussion of treatments. Just dosages and how it enters the cell but little top nothing on previous efficacy regarding viral treatments. It also makes suggestions for treatment algorithms which is based on what anecdotal experience or evidence? It needs to be rewritten.
