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#### **SPECIFIC COMMENTS TO AUTHORS**

NAFLD emerged as the most common chronic liver cell damage worldwide and strongly associated with an increased risk of CVD. Raika Jamali et al. reviewed the relationship between them and the possibility of cooperation. This topic is a very practical clinical problem, but it is not easy to summarize. One of the highlights of this paper is the novel structure of the manuscript which introduces the theme by asking questions. At the same time, the tables and figures are simple and easy to understand. However, there are some limitations in this manuscript: 1. Only 38 references are included in this review, which is obviously not enough; 2. The deconstruction is confusing, such as [Does the severity of NAFLD histology further increase CVD mortality risk?] affects the fluency of manuscripts; 3. The content of this paper does not tell readers clearly how to cooperate between the two disciplines, but more describes the relationship between the diseases, which is not consistent with the theme; 4. The range of CVD is large, and the manuscript does not clearly describe the relationship between different types of CVD and NAFLD, as well as how to carry out cooperation, which only describes part of the role of markers is lack of innovation.
