The following issues are associated with the improvement of the article. 2 The written skill is not good enough and some concepts need clarification. Severe and refractory disease should not be described together in case of confusion. The author also should state that whether the purpose of this article is to compare Western methods with TCM methods or to promote a combination of the two methods. 3 The citation is inadequate and some low quality studies have been included. 4 The author stated the management if mainly based on clinical experience. They are suggested to include some results of evidence-based researches. 5 TCM diagnosis is lack in this study emphasizing TCM methods. And TCM treatment must based on TCM classification of this disease, say, syndrome or Zheng. 6 Please correct numerous grammar errors and typo errors. I suggest the authors to have professional counsel fix English writing and organization problem throughout the rest of the article.
