**COMMENTS TO AUTHORS**

The paper gave a detailed data to assess the effect of Professor Tong Xiaolin's thought in the treatment of diabetic gastroparesis with severe nausea and vomiting by analyzing the clinical electronic medical record. The results showed that there was a statistically significant improvement of Nausea and Vomiting score during the follow-up. It is confirmed that TCM treatment substantially improved nausea and vomiting, as well as overall gastroparesis symptoms. The use of “combination of symptoms, syndrome and disease” to treat DGP with refractory nausea and vomiting may be a new treatment option. The manuscript can be revised as a brief report.
